During worship services, we provide infant and toddler nurseries for children 3 years old and younger. These nurseries are located in the hallway under the auditorium.



During the Sunday morning worship service there is a Beginner Church for 3-4 year olds and a Junior Church for $K5-4^{th}$ grades. Children are guided from Sunday School classes to beginner church which meets in room 122 (down the stairs at the rear of the auditorium).
