During worship services, we provide infant and toddler nurseries for children 3 years old and younger. These nurseries are located in the hallway under the auditorium.



During the Sunday morning worship service there is a **Beginner Church** for 3-4 year olds and a **Junior Church** for K5 -4^{th} grades. Children are guided from Sunday School classes to beginner church which meets in room 122 (down the stairs at the rear of the auditorium).



Restrooms are located down the stairwell at the back of the auditorium. An usher will be glad to point you in the right direction or show you where they are on the building map.



Handicapped accessible restrooms are available on either floor of the church. An usher can guide you to these or to a handicapped accessible water fountain. If you are unable to climb the stairs, or have difficulty doing so, an usher will be glad to escort you to the **elevator** located through the door by the piano.



All Sunday sermons are available at *ccbcathens.com* as is our statement of faith and other helpful information about the church.


