During worship services, we provide infant and toddler nurseries for children 3 years old and younger. These nurseries are located in the hallway under the auditorium.



During the Sunday morning worship service there is a **Beginner Church** for 3-4 year olds and a **Junior Church** for K5—4<sup>th</sup> grades. Children are guided from Sunday School classes to beginner church which meets in room 122 (down the stairs at the rear of the auditorium).
