

We hope the following information will help you feel at home while you are at “The Creek.”



During worship services, we provide infant and toddler **nurseries** for children 3 years old and younger. These nurseries are located in the hallway under the auditorium.



During the Sunday morning worship service there is a **Preschool Church** for 3-4 year olds and a **Junior Church** for K5—4<sup>th</sup> grades. Children are guided from Sunday School classes to Preschool Church which meets in room 122 (down the stairs at the rear of the auditorium).



**Restrooms** are located down the stairwell at the back of the auditorium. An usher will be glad to point you in the right direction or show you where they are on the building map.



**Handicapped** accessible restrooms are available on either floor of the church. An usher can guide you to these or to a handicapped accessible water fountain. If you are unable to climb the stairs, or have difficulty doing so, an usher will be glad to escort you to the elevator located through the door by the piano.

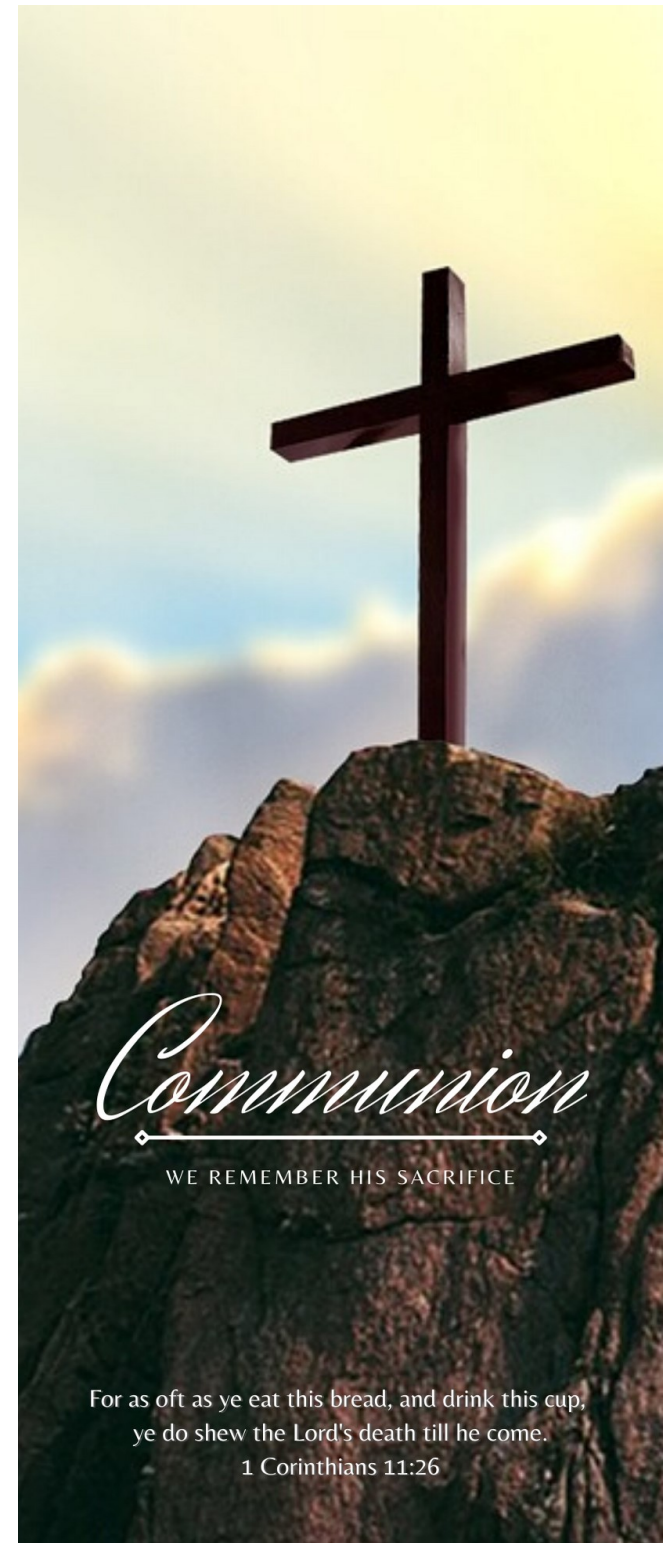
